Where to go if we have any concerns?

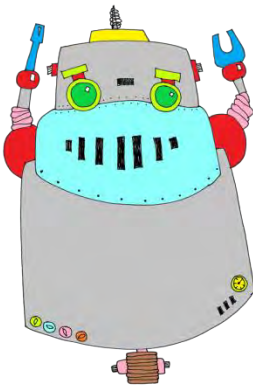
Focus

Identify a group of trusted adults if they are ever worried or concerned about anything when using technology.

Learning Intention

I can identify a group of trusted adults if I am ever worried or concerned about anything when using technology.

Robot Guardian – Rocket



Resources

- Trusted Adults worksheet – hand outline
- Presentation on trusted adults.

Introduction

Go through the presentation on trusted adults. Discuss who Rocket should speak to if his computer ever goes wrong or breaks. Next, discuss that Rocket was watching a video online and someone used bad language, or a swear word. Ask the children if it was 'his' fault? Ensure that the children understand that it was not his fault, and sometimes things can pop-up or happen whilst using the internet, computers or technology that might be upsetting or not very nice. Establish that if anything upsetting happens or goes wrong when using a computer, tablet or mobile phone they should switch the screen off and that it is important to find and report it to a trusted adult immediately. Ask the children and discuss – What trusted adults could they tell? Can they think of five?

Task and Activity

Children to use the hand worksheet. They need to write five trusted adults, one for each finger.

Plenary and Assessment Check

Share who the children chose as trusted adults. Correct any misconceptions, such as adults they can't trust or adults they might go to in this context.
